

# EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

## STADIUM VISITOR, WORKER & PATRON - INSTRUCTIONS



At Westpac Stadium we take our role as host very seriously. As our guest, your safety is our first priority.

Please take some time now to study this document and locate your nearest emergency exit.

### In the event of an emergency, here's what you should do:



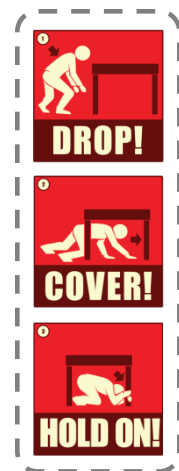
#### FIRE – Evacuate and Assemble

- If you hear a continuous fire alarm, immediately leave the building via the nearest safe exit
- Follow the instructions of Safety Wardens, security staff and the PA system announcements



#### EARTHQUAKE – Drop, Cover and Hold

- Drop to the ground, get under cover and hold on
- If you are seated in the stadium bowl, remain in your seat
- Do not evacuate (unless instructed to do so)
- Wait for the shaking to stop and then follow the instructions of Safety Wardens, security staff and the PA announcements
- Do not enter the car park



#### DISABILITY

- If you require assistance, please inform venue security and staff



#### EVACUATION

- If there is no apparent alarm and you need to evacuate, please follow instructions of Safety Wardens and security staff

**Follow the instructions of Wardens and security staff at all times, they are trained in our Emergency Procedures**

Westpac Stadium has a Public Address system, big screens at each end of the field, and TV screens in the public areas of the stadium that will be used to communicate in the event of an emergency – please listen and watch for further information

#### Remember:

- Do not use the lifts
- Walk in an orderly manner at all times and remain calm
- Do not carry anything downstairs with you
- Watch for falling items or other hazards
- When instructed, assemble at the Emergency Assembly Point
- Do not return to the building until instructed to do so by emergency personnel

#### Useful Tips:

- Prior to arrival, arrange a safe meeting point outside the venue in case you should become separated
- On arrival, familiarise yourself with your location, your nearest exits and the best route to them, and identify the safety wardens and security staff
- Wardens and security staff are distinguishable by their yellow flouro clothing and 'Red Badge' insignia
- Ask our friendly staff if you have any questions or concerns
